Cabin Counselor

Are you good at... connecting with others? creating inclusive and supportive atmospheres? working in teams? Then being a Cabin Counselor is for you! Cabin Counselors have a huge impact on our campers' experience at TFC. They are one of the biggest reasons campers return year after year. You will work in a team of 3-4 other staff to ensure all social, emotional, and physical needs of our campers are met for the entirety of their stay.

Lead Cabin Counselor

Do you... enjoy problem solving? have experience leading others? want to make sure campers and staff alike have an unforgettable experience? Then being a Lead Cabin Counselor is for you! In addition to connecting with campers and making their experience memorable you will ensure staff are supported, your cabin is on schedule, and parents have their questions answered.

Outpost Counselor

Do you.... love the outdoors? enjoy sleeping in tents? like cooking your own food? enjoy helping others learn outdoor skills? Then working in The Outpost is for you! Much like a cabin counselor you are foundational in a camper's experience. Help make sure camper needs are met while role modeling and taking an active part in daily routine at the Outpost. Outpost life includes daily chores, cooking food for the group, and preparing for trips. Staff will drive on off-site trips.

Outpost Coordinator

Do you... love the outdoors? have experience leading trips? like making plans? Then you might want to be the Outpost Coordinator. In addition to the Outpost Counselor role you will lead off-site trips, provide support for your staff, and assist in the creation and implementation of the Outpost Daily Schedule.



Float Counselor

Are you good at...working with others? being flexible? constant change? Then being a float counselor is for you! Float counselors move in and out of cabin groups depending on the needs of the day. Fill in for staff on their time off, those who are sick, or assist a cabin who needs more hands. May lead programs if that is what is needed. Being flexible and quickly adapting to new situations is key!

Program Instructor

Are you.... creative? outgoing? enthusiastic? willing to get up in front of the whole camp for a song or dance while dressed in a funny costume? Then being a part of the program staff is for you! Our program staff are responsible for the planning and implementation of daily activities in program areas, at evening program, and at special events. Must be able to "think outside the box" and adapt activities to campers as needed.

- **Waterfront Director** - Must be 21 or older, have current Lifeguard certification, and previous lifeguard experience. Must be able to think and act quickly in emergency situations.
- **Waterfront Aide** – Must have current Lifeguard certification or the ability to complete course. Must be able to think and act quickly in emergency situations.
- **Lead Challenge Facilitator** – Must have previous facilitation experience, able to think/act quickly in emergency situations, and not be fearful of heights. Will be present and responsible for all challenge programs when running. Assisted by other challenge facilitators.
- **Challenge Facilitator** –Prefer individuals with previous facilitation experience. Must be able to think and act quickly in emergency situations and not be fearful of heights.
- **Creative Arts Instructor** – Crafts, Music, Dance, Jewelry, Painting, Poetry, Tie Dye, etc
- **Barn & Garden Instructor** – Small Animal Care & Interaction, gardening- planting & harvesting, etc
- **Sports & Recreation Instructor** – Group Games, Individual/Team Sports, Fitness, Recreation, etc
- **Outdoor Education Instructor** - Outdoor Cooking, Campfire Building, Archery, Nature Activities, etc

Camp Nurse

Responsible for the overall administration and documentation of medications for campers and staff on-site. Oversees and corrects general first aid given by staff. ***Inquire for stipend.***
